### **Personal Data We Collect**

We only collect data that helps us achieve the purpose set out in this Privacy Policy. We will not collect any additional data beyond the data listed below without notifying you first.

### **Data Collected in a Non-Automatic Way**

We may also collect the following data when you perform certain functions on our Site:

1. First and last name;
2. Email address; and
3. Message.

This data may be collected using the following methods:

1. Contact form.

### **How We Use Personal Data**

Data collected on our Site will only be used for the purposes specified in this Privacy Policy or indicated on the relevant pages of our Site. We will not use your data beyond what we disclose in this Privacy Policy.

The data we collect when the user performs certain functions may be used for the following purposes:

**How Long We Store Personal Data**

User data will be stored for seven years.

You will be notified if your data is kept for longer than this period.

**How We Protect Your Personal Data**

I protect client data by storing all information in secure, password-protected systems with multi-factor authentication. Only I have access to client files. Data is used solely for service delivery and is never shared without written consent.

While we take all reasonable precautions to ensure that user data is secure and that users are protected, there always remains the risk of harm. The Internet as a whole can be insecure at times and therefore we are unable to guarantee the security of user data beyond what is reasonably practical.

**Children**

We do not knowingly collect or use personal data from children under 13 years of age. If we learn that we have collected personal data from a child under 13 years of age, the personal data will be deleted as soon as possible. If a child under 13 years of age has provided us with personal data their parent or

guardian may contact our privacy officer.

We use client information solely to provide personalized sustainability consulting services, create customized plans, track progress, communicate with clients, and maintain accurate business records. We do not sell or share client information with third parties for marketing or unrelated purposes.

Client data is stored in secure, password-protected systems accessible only to the Consultant. All devices used to access client information are protected with multi-factor authentication. Data is stored in reputable, secure cloud services and is used exclusively for service delivery.

We retain client information only as long as necessary to provide services and maintain required business records. Essential financial and contractual records may be retained for 3–7 years for tax and compliance purposes. Other personal data, including photos and optional health metrics, may be deleted or anonymized upon request or after a defined retention period.

Clients may request access to their personal information, request corrections, or request deletion of non-essential data at any time. Clients may also withdraw consent for optional data collection, such as photos or health-related metrics. Certain records required for legal or financial purposes cannot be deleted.

We use secure third-party service providers for functions such as payments, scheduling, communication, and data storage. These providers maintain their own privacy and security standards. We do not control and are not responsible for the privacy practices of these third-party services, but we only use reputable providers.

We do not store or process credit card numbers or bank account information. All payments are handled through secure, PCI-compliant third-party processors such as PayPal, Stripe, or Square. We only receive confirmation of payment, not full financial details.

We may contact clients via email, phone, or text message for scheduling, service updates, and essential program communication. Clients may opt out of non-essential messages at any time, but cannot opt out of communications required to deliver services.

We may update this Privacy Policy from time to time to reflect changes in our practices or legal requirements. Clients will be notified of any material updates, and continued use of services constitutes

acceptance of the revised policy.
